



LOCAL PLAYGROUND DIRECTIONS

American Village Park, 4703 American Dr. Durham 27705

From 15-501, take Morreene Rd (Exit 108A). Turn left over the bridge and turn left again onto the first street (American Dr). Keep going straight and American Village Park will be on the left. Equipment specifically for younger children.

Other Amenities: grills, picnic tables & shelters

Oval Drive Park, 2200 West Club Blvd. Durham 27705

From 15-501, take I-85 N/Hillandale Rd (Exit 174A). Turn right, go past the golf course, and turn left at the traffic light onto Club Blvd. Oval Drive Park is on the right at the bottom of the hill, and the playground is marked by a sign.

Other Amenities: adult softball field, basketball courts, grills, picnic tables & shelters, and tennis courts

Indian Trail Park, 1701 Albany Street Durham 27705

From 15-501, take I-85 N/Hillandale Rd (Exit 174A). Turn right, then turn left onto Indian Trail (before the golf course). Indian Trail Park is on the right, just before Albany St, and the playground is marked by a sign.

Other Amenities: greenway access and picnic tables

Forest Hills Park, 1639 University Dr. Durham 27707

From I-85, exit onto Gregson (Northgate Mall exit), which will become Vickers. At the end of Vickers, turn right onto University Drive.

Other Amenities: athletic field, greenway access, grills, picnic tables & shelters, tennis courts, and recreation center

Rockwood Park, 2310 Whitley Dr. Durham 27707

Coming from the south, use University Drive. As soon as you pass "Little Gym," turn right onto Shoreham Rd. At the stop sign, turn right onto Whitley Rd. Rockwood Park is at the end of Whitley Rd. Coming from the north, pass Forest Hills Park and turn left onto Summit St. Take a right onto Stuart St. and then a left onto Whitley Road. Rockwood Park is at the end of Whitley Rd.

Other Amenities: basketball courts, grills, and picnic tables

Edison Center, 500 W Murray Ave. Durham 27704 Tel. 919.560.4270

Coming from Chapel Hill or south Durham, take 15-501 to I-85 N and exit onto N Duke St (Exit 176). Go straight onto Duke St. go past the sign for the NC Museum of Life and Science, and turn right onto Murray Ave. The Edison Center is on your left and marked by signs.

Chapel Hill Community Center, 120 South Estes Dr. Chapel Hill 27514 919.968.2743

Coming from Durham, take 15-501 S to Chapel Hill. The center is on Estes Dr. between Franklin St. and 15-501 S, near the basketball court.

Other Amenities: indoor pool, gymnasium, climbing wall, rose garden, walking trails, bocce ball courts
